Arrangement is word by word; references are to pages. Because everything in the book concerns libraries in some way, more specific entry points are used wherever possible. Entries for organizations should be assumed to be for their *libraries* unless otherwise stated.

Groups and other subordinate bodies of CILIP are entered under *CILIP*. Individual universities are entered under the distinctive word, or the personal name, in their title, rather than under 'University of ...'.

Synonyms: There is a particular problem in this volume with use of *internet/world wide web*, *automation/computers*, *information technology*, etc., and with *digital/electronic*. On the whole, terms have been indexed as used by the contributors, and readers are urged to try the various possibilities. Some cross-references have been provided.

The endnotes, the contributors' names, and the list of libraries on pp. 385–6 are not indexed.
